# *Constellations*

for 2 Pianos and Tibetan Singing Bowl

**Performance Rules:**

The Tibetan Singing Bowl player begins and ends the piece.

The Pianists can begin at their own pace. Once they begin, they can either play the page from the top to bottom at their own pace or pick and choose which "constellation" to play next.

Every "constellation" must be played as written, but the pianists can interpret the meaning of this. No individual notes are random.

The "constellations" can be performed in other octaves.

The Tibetan Singing Bowl player signals when the piece ends.

*"Andromeda"* *"Aquarius"*
